About Cortona...

Cortona is one of the true jewels of the Tuscan "hill towns." Cortona, which is often called the "City of Art," has its origin as an Etruscan city that pre-dates Roman times with sections of its walls dating back some 2500 years. As is typical of Tuscan hill-towns, Cortona is a walled city that, for purposes of defense, was built atop a prominent geographical point. The stone buildings and streets not only have the romance, style, and charm that are particular to Tuscany, but also speak of the lives and times Cortona has witnessed. An encounter with Cortona is an encounter with music & art, with history and with spirituality. Getting to know this timeless city is a real rediscovery of our past. Cortona offers testimony to its history as well as an enchanting view of the landscape enclosed by Lake Trasimeno and the Apennine mountains.

About this workshop...

Saturday April 25, 2009

Participants arrive in Cortona from Rome with a Toscana Americana escort and check in at Hotel Oasi. For the rest of the afternoon, participants may want to either rest or explore Cortona before welcome meeting at La Saletta for a wine and chocolate tasting. Mmmm

yum! Then off to dinner at one of the fine restaurants that Patrick will take us to for the next week. Afterwards, we will be taken back to our hotel by taxi.

Sunday April 26

I will do a demo at the Hotel Oasi and if time allows, you'll be able to paint after that till we break for lunch. In the demo, I will go over in general the fundamentals of plein air painting, sharing with you my thought process, technique, etc. Every day we paint, we will go over at least one of the four important basics for developing a good painting. Values, color and color mixing, shapes, and edges. After lunch, you will have three wonderful hours to paint there. I will be there to help and instruct with any problems that may arise. We will talk about composition and design and deciding how to simplify our subject. Critique.

Monday April 27

This morning we will be taking a taxi to Cortona/Piazza Garibaldi for our morning session where I will let you capture the morning light and I will demo in the afternoon session going over all the essentials and in capturing the light and dealing with the light source when painting en plein air. Critique

Tuesday April 28

This is a real treat!! You will love it! Patrick is taking us via train to Florence for the day. Lunch will be provided and then off the Uffizi gallery. After exploring Florence and taking in all the beauty, we will return to Cortona for wine and dinner as usual. This could become a wonderful habit! You may want to take a lot of reference or even bring your sketch book.

Wednesday April 29

Group painting session both morning and afternoon. Smaller demos will be done, if needed, to emphasize any problems participants may be having. Critique.

Thursday April 30

Group morning and afternoon sessions in Piazza Garbaldi with possible demo, going over any questions, etc. and final critique.

Friday May 1

Day trip. Depart Cortona to Passignano and Lago Trasimeno by train followed by boat to Isola Maggiore. We will enjoy the sites and have lunch before we return to Cortona where will have our farewell wine tasting dinner. :-(I know you will love this experience and bring home many wonderful memories to last a lifetime, especially if they are on your canvases!! And I know Italy will call to you again.

Note: Do not pack prohibited items in carry-on-luggage! They will be confiscated. Bring your smallest, lightest weight version of each item. Remember that you will need to carry your own gear as we travel from one painting location to another.

Paints

- 1. Titanium White
- 2. Cadmium Yellow Lemon
- 3. Cadmium Yellow Pale
- 4. Cadmium Red Light.

- 5. Alizarin Crimson
- 6. Thalo Blue
- 7. Ultramarine Blue
- 8. Yellow Ochre
- 9. Terra Rosa
- 10. Ivory Black

Brushes

3-4 bristle (hogs hair) filbert brushes ranging in sizes from 2-20 (small, medium & large)

3-4 softer brushes of either a sable, mongoose or synthetic sable ranging in sizes from 2-20 (small, medium & large)

1 each bristle and softer flat brush in both a smaller size (1/4-1/2 inch) and a larger one (1 inch wide)

One round softer hair brush for detail if needed.

Suggested brands are Silver Brush, Royal & Langnickel, Isabey and Winsor & Newton.

Canvas

Canvas 5-10 panels such as Raymar cotton canvas panels or Windriver Art cotton canvas panels or Fredrex Canvas Panels (small ones, 11 x 14 or under)

Palette

This may be included in your easel. If not, a non-white palette of your choice, preferably 12 x 16, toned, Either plexi glass, wood, etc. (no glass due to possible breakage)

Easel

Easels used for plein air painting, such as half-sized French Easel, (M.A.B.E.F. or Julian are good brands), Open Box M, Guerrilla Box or Easy L

Miscellaneous

1" or 2" Angular trowel shaped palette knife or similar

Brush washer air tight container or other air tight container for Mineral Spirits (Mineral spirits will have to be purchased once you arrive in Europe)

Paper towels (Viva Kleenex is good) (regular paper towels may be available in Cortona)

Razor blade or scraper to remove paint from palette

Sketch book, pencils and sharpener if needed (11 x 14 or smaller) for drawing and taking notes.
